As part of our year of community care, we've been afforded the opportunity to host two quite special groups through our accompanist, Allan, and our dear friend, president of the Norfolk Chamber Consort, Jake Keller. This month, VBCC will host the Norfolk Chamber Consort in their first ever concert in Virginia Beach and the Virginia Musical Theatre as they begin rehearsals for the next production in our very own Austin Fellowship Hall!

It is such a joy to be able to offer our space in this way for such special local arts groups, and we are all quite excited about these new community partners in our space.

Many of us are moved by the arts, and I believe it is no secret that I was considering working in theatre before feeling my call to ministry. There is something about a wonderful piece of music, theatre, or art that pulls us in and touches our hearts. There is something holy in the creative act as we channel the creative energy of God to make something new.

Both groups are working on productions that celebrate America's 250th birthday. How fortunate we are to be able to house these groups as they share the beauty of the arts with our community.

The Norfolk Chamber Consort will present “Independent: 250th Anniversary of the Nation (1776)” on February 21 at 3 pm. The concert commemorates 250 years of our nation’s independence. It features music from familiar American composers like William Billings, Charles Ives, Amy Beach, Harvey Stokes, Scott Joplin, Florentine Price, John Phillip Sousa, and more. Performers include Andrey Kasparov, Oksana Lutsyshyn, Bianca Hall, the Old Dominion University Madrigal Singers, Harvey Stokes, Tim Seibles, Christopher Brydge, Larry Giddens, and the Invencia Piano Duo.

They invite us to join them at 2 pm for a “Community Sing” where we can learn two of the songs in the program and then participate as part of the program’s finale. I will be there, and I hope you will be, too, as we make a point of coming out to support this community partner in their artistic endeavors and celebrate America’s creation and life.

Between now and then, Virginia Musical Theatre will spend many evenings and Saturdays in our building working on their next production, 1776. It’s the summer of 1776, and the nation is on the brink of declaring independence—if only the Founding Fathers can agree to do it. Follow John Adams, Benjamin Franklin, and Thomas Jefferson as they navigate heated debates, political drama, and the birth of a nation in this inspiring and entertaining retelling of history. The show will run February 27th-March 1st at the Sandler Center, with Allan Decipulo as its Musical Director.

We are so fortunate to provide space for both of these talented groups, and all that is left in our community care is to show up and support them in their works! I hope to see you there.




